Opinion

We have audited the accompanying annual financial results of VISHWARAJ SUGAR INDUSTRIES LIMITED (the "Company") for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2026 attached herewith, being prepared and submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 and 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended (the "Listing Regulation").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanation given to us, the aforesaid Financial Results:

2. Sugar production being seasonal, performance of one quarter is not indicative of the trend for the whole year.
3. The financial results of the company have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 as amended by the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) (Amendment) Rules 2016.
4. The Financial results recommended by the Audit Committee are considered and approved by the Board of Directors at their meeting held on 29th May, 2026.
5. The Financial results have been reviewed by the Statutory Auditors of the Company as per Regulation 33 and 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended.
6. During the year the state government of Karnataka vide its order.CI 324 SGF 2025 dated:08th November,2025 has increased the sugarcane price by Rs.50/- above FRP fixed by Central Government and increase in cost of Raw material and other expenses during the year has resulted in loss. The company has incurred Loss of Rs.28.17 crore and cash loss of Rs.9.89 crore during the year.
7. For the year ending 31st March,2026 the provision has not been made for Current tax liability as there is no Taxable total profit as per Income tax computation. Further Deferred tax provision has been provided by the company on timing difference of value of assets and liabilities as per the tax rate applicable.
8. During the period 01st April,2025 to 31st March,2026 the company has disposed off the complaints received from Investors/Shareholders.
9. Expected Credit Loss:The company has provided the provision for 'Expected Credit Losses' of Rs.99.04 Lakhs as per Ind AS-109 till year end out of the Trade and other receivables which are outstanding for more than 365 days during the year and such amount has been debited to statement of Profit and Loss account.
10. Figures for the quarter ended 31st March, 2026 and 31st March, 2025 represent the difference between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the unaudited figures of nine months ended 31st December, 2025 and 31st December, 2024.
11. The company has commenced its commercial operations of new Molasses and Cane juice/syrup based 150KLPD Ethanol Distillery Plant from January-2026 and hence the total Distillery capacity of the company is 250KLPD distillery.
